MAINTAINING YOUR BOILER

Forgetting to have your boiler serviced can have serious repercussions. From unexpected financial outlay to health consequences; a faulty or broken boiler can have a significant impact.

Boiler Maintenance Tips



- Balancing radiators – this helps to maintain an even heat throughout the house. If the ones furthest away are cooler than those near the boiler, they need adjusting.
- Bleeding radiators – overtime air can become trapped in your radiators, this reduces their efficiency as some parts will be hot, some cold.

Boiler Maintenance Tips



- Boiler Flame – this should always burn blue, if it's not then you need a Gas Safe Engineer (us) to look at this as a matter of urgency.
- Accessibility of your flue – this needs to be visible. If you don't know what it is or where it is, then you need to contact us to help you. It is possible it will need moving.

Boiler Maintenance Tips



- Silt/Debris in radiator – this occurs over time, and again can reduce the efficiency of your radiator. It is likely it will need to be flushed out. You can usually tell this is the case as the top is warm but the bottom part remains cold.
- Boiler Pressure – to ensure that your boiler is working productively and can circulate hot water around your pipes and radiators, it needs to be set at the right pressure.

Boiler Maintenance Tips



- Maintenance of your boiler – to truly get the best out of your boiler you need to give it some care and attention.

Just once a year, will see you reap the rewards. Ensuring that you help prevent breakdowns, keep heating bills low and maximise it's lifespan.
